



## **Special Announcement from the Project Management Institute (PMI) Atlanta Chapter Scholarship Offering To Commemorate PMI Atlanta's 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary**

The PMI Atlanta Chapter offers three \$2000 scholarships each year. Money can be applied to either tuition, books, or other legitimate school expenses incurred with attendance in Project Management related courses leading to a bachelor's or higher degree.

### **Eligibility:**

PMI Atlanta will accept applications from students enrolled in either of the following:

- Bachelor's degree program enrolled in a minimum of three undergraduate courses, and pursuing a Project Management or related major.
- An advanced (Masters) degree program in a minimum of two graduate courses, and pursuing a Project Management or related major.

#### Required

- (1). Enrollment or proof of intended enrollment in a metro Atlanta college/university (Eligibility below).
- (2). Applicant must be on our Member Roll for the PMI-Atlanta Chapter at the time of application.
- (3). Must attach an official transcript from last school attended and the current registration document.

#### Optional

- (1). Essay -The applicant is encouraged to provide a short essay - not to exceed two (2) pages (800 words) single spaced - on "My Commitment to Project Management as a Profession".
- (2). Extra curricular activities and community work.
- (3). Volunteer work within PMI Atlanta.

All materials must be returned together except the references as explained below. PMI Atlanta will not accept incomplete applications.

References - Required from class instructors of curriculum to which applicant is currently or will be enrolled during the next session of the classes. This should be provided on the school and/or business letterhead stationery and signed by the reference. Your references should be requested to mail the document directly to the Scholarships Chair at the address noted above.

### **Schedule:**

Scholarship Award schedule does not conform to the regular school year and is revised for the 2006 year as follows:

- Applications accepted until October 31
- Application review complete and submitted to Board for approval - November 15
- Board Award Decision complete - November 30
- Awardees and School Representatives contacted - December 21
- Transmittal of Scholarship Checks to the Schools - January (of following year)

### **Eligibility - Schools:**

Candidates must already be enrolled or intending to enroll either on a Full or Part time basis in a Degree program for Project Management Coursework within an approved metro Atlanta area college or university. Schools currently known to be offering PMI approved curriculum within the Metro Atlanta area are: Mercer, Georgia Tech, Keller Graduate School, GSU, Southern Tech, Kennesaw State, and Emory. Additional colleges and universities may also be considered.

### **Award**

The actual grant of the scholarship will be made upon presentation of proof of the applicant's registration in the appropriate course(s) at a college or university determined as acceptable by PMI Atlanta. The scholarship will only be awarded to an individual one time, and it is not renewable. Prior winners of this scholarship may not apply again.
